Questions and discussions	Welcome and Introductions: - Ori Odugbesan, MPH MD, T1D Exchange, introduced the group, reviewed the agenda, and opened with an ice breaker about what parts of Fall we are looking forward to. Center Sharing: - Stacey Hardegree, Cook Children's Hospital, presented to the group. - AIM of the project was to wean 50% of young people off insulin. - Weaning instruction form in English and Spanish. 57.9% were able to wean off insulin in 8 weeks. - Next steps such as practice drift, workflow standardization, and implementation adaption were discussed. - Discussion occurred and thoughtful questions were asked: - Participants asked about CGM usage and GLP-1 prescribing during weaning. - The potential for improving care as a result of this QI work as well as ways to collect even more helpful data. - Other centers expressed interest in duplicating this work and how to better utilize their CDCES. Review Manuscript Progress: - Ori reminded those centers reporting Smartsheet obesity data to update their data so that we can use it for an abstract with a 7/31 submission deadline.
