T2D Data Specification Review Timeline

May 2023 – T2D Data Specification Kick Off Meeting

June 2023 – August 2023 – Subgroups deliberation and modification of TID Specification.

September 2023 – Consensus on critical elements/Literature review for validation

October 2023 – Modified Delphi with Stakeholders


Data Science Committee review and vote
