



Brainstorming

Ideal process for selecting future journals

Make the work of network more relevant to high impact factor journals

- Numbers, historical trends, interventions
- Descriptive that can answer questions with large Collaborative numbers
- Longitudinal analyses

Network direction to consider:

- Interventions across network (not just a subset) in real world care
- Take on more research protocols that are implementation science
- Making Collaborative population available for research studies
