

8th Annual T1D Exchange Learning Session 2024

November 2024, Chicago, IL

- 1. What are the dates/times of the Learning Session?
 - a. Monday November 11, 7am-5pm (CST).
- 2. When should I fly into Chicago?
 - a. Since we will be starting early Monday morning, we recommend arriving by Sunday morning/afternoon November 10.
- 3. Do I have to book my own flights?
 - Yes, you will need to book and purchase all transportation to and from the Learning Session
- 4. Where will the Learning Session take place?
 - a. The Learning Session will be held in Chicago, II, hosted at the Chicago Marriott Downton Magnificent Mile (540 Michigan Ave, Chicago, IL 60611).
- 5. Where can I find the agenda?
 - a. The agenda can be found on the Learning Session page of the website. Use this <u>link</u> to view details.
- 6. What costs are being covered by T1D Exchange?
 - a. T1DX will cover hotel costs for two attendees per clinical center (please indicate on RSVP)
 - b. Breakfast and lunch on Monday, November 11 for all attendees.
- 7. What costs are not being covered by T1D Exchange?
 - a. Flights
 - b. Taxis, gas mileage, parking
 - c. Meals/Snack outside of meals provided.
 - d. Hotel rooms for additional team members
 - e. Hotel rooms before the Learning Session and for ADEPT
- 8. Do I need to register?
 - a. Yes, we ask that you please submit your registration on the Learning Session website using this <u>link</u>.
 - b. Please submit one reservation for each attendee by **October 10th**, **2024**.
- 9. Do I have to book my own room?
 - a. Yes, we ask that you book directly though the hotel on our event page. Use this <u>link</u> and click on "I have an access code" and type in the code T1DX-LS2024. This will open the room block up to allow you to select Sunday as an option. All members of the team can use this link and enter the code.



- b. As a reminder T1DX will only cover Sunday November 10 and Monday November 11 for two team members per center. Please email qi@t1dexchange.org with the names and email of who should be covered from your center.
- 10. How do I know if my room with the hotel is really booked
 - a. You will receive confirmation with the hotel before the Learning Session
- 11. Can I add extra nights before and after the Learning Session?
 - a. Yes, please indicate that when you book your rooms with the hotel using this link. As a reminder T1DX will only cover Sunday November 10 and Monday November 11 for two team members per center.
- 12. How many team members are allowed to join the Learning Session
 - a. T1DX will cover hotel costs for **two** attendees per clinical center. Centers are allowed to bring more team members, but their hotel rooms will not be covered.
- 13. Will there be CME/CEU for the learning session?
 - a. There will be no CME/CEU credit offered during this year's session.
- 14. Can some of my team join the learning session virtually?
 - a. Yes- we will offer virtual attendance for an unlimited number of team members. Link to website for registration coming soon.
- 15. For Chicago hospitals, is there a limit to the number of team members invited?
 - a. We encourage you to invite a large representation of your team to the learning session. There is space for you to bring 10 team members. We think this is a terrific opportunity for residents and fellows as well.
- 16. I have dietary restrictions. How do I share that information
 - a. Please indicate on the RSVP any dietary restrictions or accommodations.
- 17. Are there any "to dos" in preparation for the Learning Session?
 - a. We have issued a call for abstracts for the conference, in collaboration with the Journal of Diabetes. We will announce abstract decisions this summer and details on the posters. Poster files should be shared with QI@t1dexchange.org when they are finished. T1DX will print the posters and will bring them to the conference for viewing. Authors of accepted abstracts may receive an invitation to give an oral presentation on their abstract topic. Use this <u>link</u> to submit an abstract.
- 18. What is the dress code?

- 19. How many abstracts can a center submit?
 - a. We are not limiting the number of abstracts that a center can submit. However, abstract should relate to the topics/primary drivers of the respective adult and pediatric Key Driver Diagrams.

- 21. Am I required to attend the Learning Session to attend ADEPT?



- a. No, you are not required, but we highly recommend attending both. **Two** team members registration for ADEPT will be waived after attending the Learning Session, so it is a great opportunity to attend both.
- 22. Will virtual attendees be able to preset?
 - a. We ask that you facilitate a member of your team attending in person to present on your behalf for ease of audio and video purposes.
- 23. Will there be a clinic tour this year?
 - a. We will not be visiting clinics in their physical space this year, but we will still get to see photos, videos, and see what makes the Chicago T1DX-QI centers unique.
