

### Checklist to Assess New Quality Measure Statement

<b>Face Validity</b>	Does the measure have face validity in terms of assessing the construct of interest? Has the right data source been selected? Is recall bias a concern?	<input type="checkbox"/>	Increase % pediatric patients with documented transition plan from xx to yy
<b>Discriminant Validity</b>	Does the measure discriminate between poor and excellent quality care? Is it too easy or too difficult to pass the measure?	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Ambiguous terms</b>	Are ambiguous terms used in the measure statement? Can those terms be made more specific?	<input type="checkbox"/>	Operational definition for what is essential to qualify as a documented "plan" Is this the most meaningful to the patient?
<b>Data source</b>	Does the wording of the measure fit the planned data source?	<input type="checkbox"/>	Discrete field available for data mapping?
<b>Time windows</b>	If relevant, are time windows defined for denominator? For numerator?	<input type="checkbox"/>	Each month, quarter, year
<b>Identifying denominator</b>	Are there potential challenges in identifying the sample for the denominator	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Identifying numerator</b>	Are there potential challenges in identifying numerator events/actions?	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Multiple actions</b>	If multiple actions are required to pass an measure, should all elements have to be satisfied (all or none scoring) or should the individual elements be scored separately?	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Multiple events</b>	If an eligible event/action occurs multiple times for one patient, how many times will you assess the event/action?	<input type="checkbox"/>
