



9th Annual T1D Exchange Learning Session 2025

November 11-12, 2025, Atlanta, GA

1. What are the dates/times of the Learning Session?
 - a. Tues. November 11, 8 am – 5 pm (EST) and Weds. November 12, 8 am – 3 pm (EST)
2. When should I fly into Atlanta?
 - a. Since we will be starting early Tuesday morning, we recommend arriving by Monday morning/afternoon November 10.
3. Do I have to book my own flight?
 - a. Yes, you will need to book and purchase all transportation to and from the Learning Session.
4. Where will the Learning Session take place?
 - a. The Learning Session will be held in the Whitley Hotel, Atlanta Buckhead 3434 Peachtree Road NE, Atlanta, GA 30326
5. Where can I find the agenda?

6. What costs are being covered by T1D Exchange?
 - a. T1DX will cover hotel costs for **two** attendees for two nights per clinical center (please indicate on RSVP)
 - b. Breakfast and lunch on Monday and Tuesday for all attendees.
7. If we are both a pediatric and adult center, does T1DX QI cover 2 or 4 people?
 - a. The peds and adult site are counted separately so we will cover Monday and Tuesday night (November 10 and 11) for two members from the peds site **AND** two members from the adult site, making it four members total.
8. What costs are **not** being covered by T1D Exchange?
 - a. Flights
 - b. Taxis, gas mileage, parking
 - c. Meals/Snack outside of meals provided.
 - d. Hotel rooms for additional team members
 - e. Hotel rooms before or after the Learning Session
9. Do I need to register?

 - b. Please submit one reservation for each attendee.
10. Do I have to book my own room?

- 11. How do I know if my hotel room is confirmed?
 - a. You will receive confirmation with the hotel before the Learning Session
- 12. Can I add extra nights before and/or after the Learning Session?
 - a. Yes, please indicate that when you book your rooms with the hotel (link coming soon). As a reminder, T1DX will only cover Monday November 10 and Tuesday November 11 for **two** team members per center.
- 13. How many team members are allowed to attend the Learning Session?
 - a. T1DX will cover hotel costs for **two** attendees per clinical center. Centers are allowed to bring more than two team members, but their hotel rooms will not be covered.
- 14. What is the hotel cost per night for clinics that want to pay for 1+ nights for additional team members?
 - a. \$229 per night.
- 15. Will there be CME/CEU for the learning session?
 - a. There will be no CME/CEU credit offered during this year's session.
- 16. Can some of my team join the learning session virtually?
 - a. Yes- we will offer virtual attendance for an unlimited number of team members. Link to website for registration coming soon.
- 17. For Atlanta hospitals, is there a limit to the number of team members invited?
 - a. We encourage you to invite a large representation of your team to the learning session. We think this is a terrific opportunity for residents and fellows as well.

- 19. Are there any "to dos" in preparation for the Learning Session?
 - a. We have issued a call for abstracts for the conference, in collaboration with the Journal of Diabetes. We will announce abstract decisions this summer and details on the posters. Poster files should be shared with QI@t1dexchange.org when they are finished. T1DX will print the posters and will bring them to the conference for viewing. Authors of accepted abstracts may receive an invitation to give an oral presentation on their abstract topic. Use this [link](#) to submit an abstract.
