Diabetes Journals Review

The **Clinical Diabetes** journal is currently being published but will be **discontinued** in early 2026 and replaced by a new publication.

We are researching journals similar to Clinical Diabetes

- Impact factor: 4.1-7
- Topic areas (content) being willing to publish QI practices, clinical work, case studies, multicenter networks
- Cost per open access article (\$1500-\$2500 per article)
- Editorial connections
- Article types
